Dear JW Brothers and Sisters,

The following Hiring Hall rule change will be effective January 4, 2010:

SHORT CALLS

A short call shall be a maximum of 14 consecutive calendar days. A short call starts no later than the next workday after dispatch, or the report date on the employer's request. An applicant who is rejected will receive four hours pay as per Article 5 Section 5.09 of the agreement and be offered the next available short call.

INDEFINITE CALLS

All calls more than 14 consecutive calendar days will be an indefinite call. An applicant who receives 14 consecutive calendar days or less of employment, through no fault of their own, will be allowed to return to their same registration date on the book when they accepted the call. **The applicant will only be allowed to do this one time and be recorded as a short call for that zone.** When the applicant is terminated from the next indefinite call the applicant shall sign at the end of the out of work book in person.

SIX WEEK CALL

There will be no more indefinite calls with six weeks or less and return to the out of work list at your previous registration date.
